

SWAP SHACK

The swap shack is for gently used goods. Please be neat and courteous.

- If you wouldn't take it, please don't leave it!
- No broken items.
- No children's car seats, mattresses or liquor.
- Please place all small items on shelves and larger items neatly against the wall on the floor.

METAL, TIRES AND BRUSH

- **Bulk metals** go into the bulk metal bin.
- **Aluminum** metal goes into the aluminum bin. *(Use the magnet provided if unsure)*
- **Tires:** Small truck or car tires only. Limit four per visit.
- **Brush:** Use appropriate brush area. **No landscapers/commercial brush allowed.**
6 YARDS MAX PER DAY
- **NO STUMPS over 6" diameter**

TRANSFER STATION RULES

- **All stickers must be affixed to front windshield. No exceptions.**
- If you have a question or need assistance, please ask attendant.
- Absolutely no picking unless in the swap shack. Contact the attendant if unclear.
- Keep your children inside your vehicle or with you at all times.
- Limit: Two trips per day. **6 YARDS MAX PER 2 TRIPS**
- **Contractor waste is not accepted please provide for a dumpster at your job site..**
- Drive slowly and for the safety of all, don't pull up beyond the yellow line.

TRANSFER STATION STICKER POLICY

7/1/2021-6/30/2022

1. A Transfer Station Permit can be obtained at the Town Clerk's Office with the following:
 - Proof of residency in the town of Haddam.
 - Automobile registration for vehicle that the sticker will be permanently attached to.
 - **\$75.00 payment (Cash or Check) NO Credit or Debit Cards (\$50.00 for residents 65 and older. Must show proof of age)**
2. There is a limit of two Transfer Station stickers per Haddam residence.
3. **Stickers must be affixed to the front windshield, no exceptions.** Vehicles with loose or misplaced stickers will not be allowed at the Transfer Station.
4. If you do not own a residential structure in Haddam, but you own vacant land, you may purchase a two week Transfer Station pass for \$50.
5. A temporary, 2-week Transfer Station pass is available for \$50 with proof of residential ownership in Haddam.
6. After March 1st, the price of the present year's Transfer Station sticker will be reduced to \$50.
7. **No box trucks or vehicles larger than a two yard/10,000 pounds GVW will be allowed to purchase a sticker.**
8. **Trailers longer than 10 feet, with side boards, or have more than 1 axle are not permitted at the Transfer Station.**
9. If you lose or misplace your recently purchased sticker you must show your receipt in order to receive a Transfer Station sticker at no charge. **Please ask for a receipt at the time of purchase.**
10. If you have purchased a new vehicle or replaced the windshield you must bring in all or part of the old sticker in order to receive a new sticker at no charge.

Fraud Punishment

If you are found to misrepresent your residential address, misrepresent losing a transfer station sticker, place your Transfer Station sticker on a different registered vehicle or fraudulently obtain a Transfer Station Sticker, you will immediately lose access to the Transfer Station and will not be able to purchase a Transfer Station sticker for 1 year (365 days).

MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE

Household trash, including soiled newspapers, greasy pizza box base, Styrofoam packing material and latex paint cans.

SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING

(Paper, Glass, Metal, & Plastic)

YES

These items all go into the single-stream bin together:

Paper

- White/colored paper (carbonless)
- Envelopes
- Manila folders
- Post-It notes and other smaller paper scraps
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Hardback/paperback books (remove hardback covers)
- Junk mail
- Cereal boxes (remove plastic liner)
- Pizza boxes (rip in half, greasy half is trash)
- Corrugated and non-corrugated cardboard

Plastic *(rinsed/cleaned)*

- Plastic #1 - 7 (except black plastics)

(ie: yogurt cups, shampoo bottles, peanut butter containers)

Check the bottom for these symbols:



- Larger plastics *(ie: laundry baskets, milk crates, and large plastic bins)*

Glass *(rinsed/cleaned)*

- Bottles and jars

Metal *(rinsed/cleaned)*

- Drink and food cans
- Aluminum food containers (clean)
- Aluminum foil (clean)
- K-Cup foil lids (detach from plastic)

Other *(rinsed/cleaned)*

- Milk cartons
- Juice boxes



Don't forget you can compost your food waste!

**ELECTRONICS, LIGHT BULBS
AND BATTERIES**

Residential electronics including televisions, computers, monitors, and printers, may be recycled in the *Take2* electronics container.

All light bulbs and batteries can be recycled in the electronics bin in the appropriate bins.

MATTRESSES AND TEXTILES

Mattresses and **Boxsprings** should be placed neatly in the mattress bin.

Textiles such as bedding, backpacks, curtains, towels, stuffed animals, gloves, belts, purses, handbags, shoes, slippers, can be placed in the textile container. Even badly stained, worn or torn items can still be recycled!

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Used motor oil and antifreeze can be put in the collection containers at the transfer station.

5 gallon max oil – 3 gallon max anti-freeze

Household hazardous waste (HHW) such as oil paints, degreasers, solvents, mercury thermometers, pesticides, weed killer, wax/polish, kerosene, gasoline and pool chemicals should be brought to the **Estuary Region collection facility: Route 9, Exit 4, Dump Road, Essex.**

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- Bottles and jars

Metal (*rinsed/cleaned*)

- Drink and food cans
- Aluminum food containers (clean)
- Aluminum foil (clean)
- K-Cup foil lids (detach from plastic)

Other (*rinsed/cleaned*)

- Milk cartons
- Juice boxes

NO

These items should be recycled elsewhere, reused, or trashed:

- Black plastics
- Plastic bags
- Dirty or food contaminated items (including greasy pizza boxes)
- Styrofoam containers
- Bubble wrap and packing peanuts
- Plastic wrap
- K-Cup coffee pods
- Plastic/Tyvek envelopes
- Paper towels/tissues
- Paper with crayon/poster paint
- Pyrex, metal/glass pots/pans, pottery
- Photos
- Light bulbs (put in electronics container)
- CDs, DVDs, and floppy disks
- Greenware and other “compostable” plastic cups and lids
- Propane tanks
- Mirrors/windows/drinking glasses
- Empty motor oil/antifreeze or any hazardous material containers (bring those to the Essex HHW site during collection times.)
